The United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF), through its Innovation Fund, announced a new cohort of startups developing open-source, blockchain-based solutions to receive equity-free investment of \$100,000 and year-long mentorship — including eSatya(Rumsan), a blockchain startup in Nepal. As part of the UNICEF Innovation Fund's portfolio, eSatya joins

a community of problem solvers developing open source solutions further with frontier technology like blockchain to address inequities children face.

Rahat: Blockchain Startup in Nepal

Rahat platform is an open source, blockchain-based humanitarian aid distribution management system. Rahat's main goal is to make the aid distribution process for vulnerable communities simple, efficient and transparent.

With the earthquake in 2015 and the current perils of Covid-19 pandemic, it's never been more obvious than now that during such crisis situations, delivering aid quickly and efficiently to the affected is vital. But distributing aid is usually a labor intensive and cumbersome process.


